

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 8 DAY 5 EXPLORE THE GREAT BARRIER REEF

Today you have the option to explore the Great Barrier Reef as you please.

Please choose one activity, you can let your tour director know your choice, the first day of your tour.

- A catamaran cruise to the Agincourt Reef via Quicksilver, a high-tech catamaran that whisks you out over the Great Barrier Reef where we'll dock at an anchored platform. You may swim and snorkel over the vast coral gardens and see colorful fish, or stay dry and explore this underwater world via a semi- submersible. A buffet lunch will be served aboard Quicksilver.
- An adventure boat trip via the Silversonic for experienced scuba divers and snorkelers out to the reef. The first introductory or certified dives are included. Morning Tea and a light lunch is included aboard the Silversonic.

Note: Snorkels, masks, fins and towels are all provided. Lycra wetsuits are provided for additional protection from the sun and possible irritations while in the water.

• Or have a relaxing spa day at the lodge. One Treatment is included, followed by lunch at the lodge.
